HERMES AIRPORTS AWARDS BOUYGUES CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO EXPAND LARNAKA AND PAFOS AIRPORTS IN CYPRUS.

Hermes Airports, concession holder for Cyprus airports, has awarded the Bouygues Bâtiment International (leader of the consortium) - Iacovou Brothers (Constructions) Ltd consortium the design-build contract for phase 2 of the extension program for Larnaka and Pafos airports in Cyprus. The project is worth a total of 170 million euros, including 119 million euros for Bouygues Bâtiment International.

This phase will increase the capacity of the airport infrastructure to meet the growing needs of air traffic in the modern age. On completion of the works, the annual capacity of Larnaka airport, on the island's south coast, will reach 12.4 million passengers, while that of Pafos, on the southwest coast, will rise to 5 million passengers.¹

¹ Compared with a current capacity of 7.5 million passengers for Larnaka and 2.7 million passengers for Pafos.

Work will take 30 months to complete at Larnaka airport and 27 months at Pafos. It will include:

- At Larnaka:
 - The construction of a 3-storey extension to the east of the existing terminal to relocate the screening checkpoints and increase their capacity, at the same time allowing for the expansion of the central walk-through retail and food and beverage areas, which will generate additional revenue.
 - The construction of a new pier with walk-in boarding and arrival gates connected to the main terminal.
 - New aircraft parking facilities.

- At Pafos:
 - The construction of an eastward extension to the existing terminal, with the redevelopment of border control, security and baggage delivery functions to accommodate the increased capacity, as well as expanded and redesigned commercial areas.
 - The extension of the southern taxiway will enhance the airport's operational flexibility.

Thanks to this extension, Cyprus' airport infrastructure will be able to sustainably support growth in passenger traffic and enhance the passenger experience for years to come, even after the end of the current concession period.

The extensions feature advanced environmental design, with the ultimate aim of achieving BREEAM certification. The security control facilities will incorporate the latest standards currently being deployed in Europe.

"This project marks a new stage for Hermes Airports in the development of Larnaka and Pafos airports, which we already completed in 2009. It illustrates Bouygues Bâtiment International's expertise in the design, construction and modernization of large-scale airport infrastructures, in the service of a quality passenger experience."

This project follows the recent award of the contract for the modernization of Paris-Beauvais Airport to the Bellova consortium, comprising Egis (leader), Serena, Bouygues Construction Airports, and Aéroports de la Côte d'Azur.
