LOSINGER MARAZZI, BOUYGUES CONSTRUCTION'S SWISS SUBSIDIARY, WINS A NEW CONTRACT IN THE CANTON OF ZUG

Losinger Marazzi will construct the new premises for the Zug public transport authority (ZVB¹) as well as a new building for the Zug emergency services (RDZ²) and the cantonal administration. At a cost of CHF 242 million (€260 million)³, this project will provide functional infrastructure and a better working environment for these public services, which play an essential role for the population of the fast-growing canton of Zug.

The current site, which already houses the ZVB and emergency services, will be completely redeveloped by Losinger Marazzi to create new facilities that meet the needs of this rapidly developing region. The ZVB will relocate to a new office building with a large underground bus parking area. The second building will be used by the RDZ, enabling the emergency services to benefit from a high-performance infrastructure serving the local population. Part of the building will also house approximately 250 workstations for the Zug cantonal authorities.

The complex will provide 26,000 m² of floor space in all. Works will begin in summer 2026 and are scheduled for completion in 2030. The project complies with the Minergie-P-ECO standard, which certifies the efficiency of the building's thermal envelope and the use of more environmentally responsible materials.

Losinger Marazzi is also working on an urban development project in Zug to convert an industrial site into a mixed-use neighbourhood with new residential, office and retail space. Delivery will take place in stages, with the first building due for completion in 2026 and the second in 2027.
