



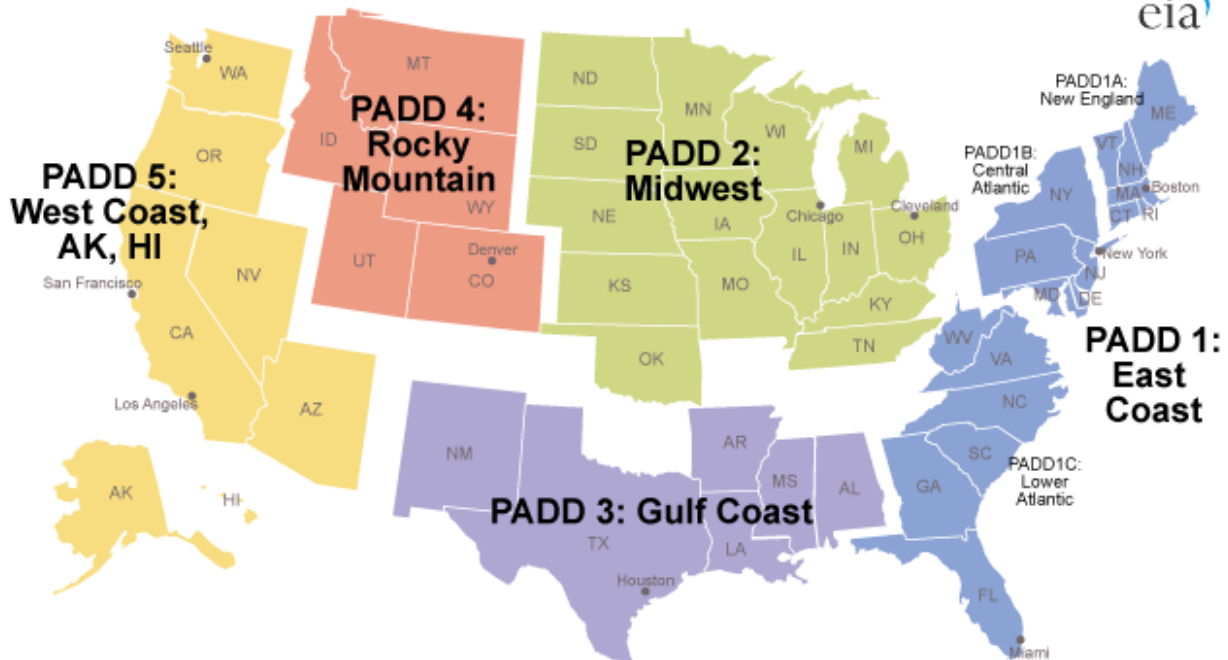
FUEL SURCHARGE NOTICE

Fuel prices fluctuate based on market conditions. Core-Mark maintains a fuel surcharge program to address changes in fuel prices and associated transportation costs. This Notice explains Core-Mark's assessment of fuel surcharges pursuant to its fuel surcharge program. policy may not apply to customers that are subject to other business or commercial terms with Core-Mark.

Core-Mark calculates its fuel surcharge using a formula based on regional diesel fuel prices published by the U.S. Energy Information Administration ("EIA") and Core-Mark operating data. Core-Mark does not use a predetermined fuel surcharge grid.

For purposes of the fuel surcharge calculation, Core-Mark utilizes the five Petroleum Administration for Defense District ("PADD") regions defined by the EIA:

FUEL SURCHARGE NOTICE

The fuel surcharge applicable to a delivery is calculated using two primary components:

$$\text{EIA Diesel Price} \times \text{Core-Mark Gallons Per Stop} = \text{Fuel Surcharge Per Stop}$$

The EIA Diesel Price is the average diesel fuel price per gallon published by the EIA's website (www.eia.gov) for the PADD region applicable to the delivery.

Core-Mark Gallons Per Stop is an annual operating standard calculated separately for each PADD region. Core-Mark reviews and refreshes the gallons-per-stop standard annually to reflect operating conditions within each region.

A new fuel surcharge rate becomes effective on the first Monday of each month using the applicable EIA diesel price from the previous week. Both the EIA diesel price and the Core-Mark gallons-per-stop standard are specific to the applicable PADD region.

$$\text{Fuel Surcharge Per Stop} \times \text{Customer Deliveries} = \text{Monthly Fuel Surcharge}$$

The resulting fuel surcharge per stop is applied to the customer's actual deliveries during the applicable month. To monitor diesel fuel prices in your region, simply visit the EIA website.

For further transparency, the fuel surcharge, when applicable, will be shown as a separate line-item charge to your invoice. The surcharge is based on the formula described above and may not equal Core-Mark's actual fuel expense associated with a particular delivery or customer location. The assessed fuel surcharge is not a separate tax or fee required by any governmental agency or entity.

Accordingly, the fuel surcharge assessed for a particular delivery may be greater than or less than Core-Mark's actual fuel expense associated with that delivery. Core-Mark's fuel surcharge program, methodology, applicable standards and fuel surcharge amounts are subject to change at Core-Mark's discretion.
